Recipients of this award must meet the following criterion:

- High school graduating senior
- Attending a two (2) or four (4) year college (A copy of Acceptance Letter Must Accompany Application)
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Must submit an official high school transcript
- <u>Must have been a member of FBCS for the preceding two (2) years</u> from date of submission of application for scholarship
- Must submit a 125 to 250 essay on the theme "How God Has Used Me to Impact the Lives of Others." (Typed; double spaced; one-sided)
- Submit Application for Scholarship

Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$500 to 2 students this year. Students may apply each year as they have financial need.
